<p>On the 25th of October 1944, "B" Company had been fighting bitterly for twenty-four hours without food of any kind. Private Gregor had made every effort to deliver the badly needed supplies. Eventually he succeeded in getting them within half a mile of the Company positions by vehicle. Realizing it would be impossible to continue further, he stopped the vehicle and continued the remaining distance on foot, carrying the heavy food containers. extremely heavy mortar fire he cheerfully made several trips from the vehicle to the company in order to accomplish the task he had set himself.

When all the ^{supplies} ~~supplies~~ had been distributed forward, Private Gregor went from position to position delivering mail and cigarettes to the troops. At all times he exposed himself to extreme danger in order to bring these small comforts to the men of his company.

Private Gregor's actions were, at all times, a source of inspiration to the men and added much to the fighting efficiency of the company.
