<p>On 25 July 1944 the Calgary Highlanders consolidated at St Andre Sur Orne under heavy shell and mortar fire which continued with only occasional brief pauses all that day and the night following.</p> <p>"D" Company was in a forward position at the south edge of the village when heavy enemy artillery concentrations were brought down upon them causing casualties and wrecking the buildings which they occupied. Private Lysne, a stretcher bearer, immediately went to the assistance of the casualties, rendered first aid treatment, rescued his comrades from the damaged buildings and evacuated them to positions of safety ignoring completely the danger from falling debris and the continued heavy shell fire.</p> <p>On two occasions that day, private Lysne crawled across stretches of open and exposed ground to reach the wounded under heavy shell and mortar fire and air attack.</p>	<p>Sgd.
