"B" Company was ordered to clear the left flank of the main exis of advance. The enemy had set up a strongly defended locality in some buildings from which they were able to sweep the main axis with accate and direct machine gun fire.

K/46430 Acting Corporal Reginald Alastar SHEPHER section leader of number 4 Platoon of "B" Company was advancing with his section when his company was pinned down by severe machine gun fire. K/46340 Acting Corporal Reginald Alastar SHEPHERD quickly appreciated the situation and pin pointed the enemy fire as coming from a house on his flank. He manoeuvred, under direct fire his section of six men. across open and difficult ground with great skill commander, Second ARMY. and daring. Once in position he led his section
