Private Walton is very young, and during the action in HOLLAND COMD, 5 CDN. INF. BDE. was the youngest soldier in his company. His duties as runner took him very often into danger-Netherlands ous territory in order that his messages could be Award delivered. Bronze Cross Ma j-Gen buring the action to clear HOOGERHEIDE on the 7th of October 1944, Private Walton, on three occasions, was asked to contact the company on "B" Company's left flank in order that messages might be delivered. On one of these occasions, after moving over six (G G SIMONDS) Lt Gen hundred yards of uncleared ground, he returned with GOC Con Forces in the Netherlands two prisoners. When wireless communication failed to operate within the company, he moved forward to

the leading platoons, who were engaged in very heavy fighting.

When the Calgary Highlanders attacked WALCHEREN ISLAND on the 28th of October 1944 over the causeway, Private Walton, under heavy enemy fire, which caused heavy casualties to our troops, carried messages for five hours, after his company's wireless set had failed to operate.
