Lieutenant Wills and his small party soon was forced to engage the enemy. One signaller was wounded. But this did not deter Lieutenant wills from his purpose. He pushed tirelessly forward through enemy shell and morter fire with the remaining signaller and his heavy equipment, making use of all the coverige could find.

Eventually he reached "A" Company and immediately set up his wireless set. Unfortunately some lengths of aerial had been lost on the way and he was unable to get into communication with headquarters. Appreciating this technical difficulty he quickly remedied the situation by connecting the wireless set to an aerial which was still intact on a partially demolished house. The set functioned properly and all the necessary information was passed back to battalion headquarters. With this information the battalion commander was able to plan a successful counter attack and relieve the stranded company.

The very difficult task which Lieutenant Wills set for himself was carried out successfully and in doing so he displayed courage of the highest order.
